This course is designed for young labour activists to create links for activism in both the community and in the workplace. As you work with a supportive group, you will build basic fundamentals and effective communication. This workshop will help you gain the confidence you need to speak up at a meeting or public event.

The Game of Life: Have you given any thought to retirement? Have you anticipated what financial hurdles you may face as you work your way through your life? The Game of Life examines all the financial curve balls we may face throughout our life in an interactive and fun way. This workshop also offers insight into how AUPE worked as part of a larger whole to promote and stand up for the rights of its members.

Activism & Wellness: Chronic stress not only compromises an individual's health, but can lead to them being an energy drain versus an asset to their team. While many of us are keen in being involved in the union we must remember that we can only contribute if we take care of ourselves as well. In this workshop we will look at ways to assist to our own wellness in order to contribute to part of an action team.

Teambuilding: In order to gain results as union activists we must work as a team. A leader can only be as strong as their team and this does not come without its own challenges. The hands on approach to teambuilding, through Koda's challenge, will help strengthen your leadership skills and build confidence.
