Dove Award

The AUPE Women's Committee has launched its search for nominations for the DOVE Award.

This annual award honours female-identifying members who have made major contributions to the betterment of women and all members of our Union.

The DOVE Award – which stands for Day of Validation and Equity – provides an opportunity for members to recognize the work of their co-workers as activists, stewards, worksite contacts and spokespeople for the union movement.

Any woman who is a regular member of AUPE in good standing with the exception of members of the current Women's Committee may be nominated.

Members should look around their own worksites, chapters and locals to find women whose union work makes a real difference for their co-workers.

A nomination may be submitted by any member or group of members. While nominations do not have to be passed by an AUPE Local Council, the committee encourages consultation of Local Councils.

Written nominations should be a minimum of 150 words in length and must outline the nominee's contribution to the betterment of women in AUPE. Video presentations will also be accepted.

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Each DOVE Award recipient receives an etched crystal memento and recipient's name is engraved on a commemorative plaque permanently displayed at AUPE Headquarters in Edmonton.
