- May mean lay offs and/or reduced hours of work
- Reduced hours of work may mean loss of benefits
- Contracting out leads to a loss of union protection
- Contracting out may lead to less pay for the same job
- Contracting out may lead to member disengagement or dissension between members

Bringing in an outside company may lead to a disturbance to worker dynamic and lead to resentment toward the employer or staff of the contracted company, resulting in a loss of overall productivity.
