RE: Prairie School for Union Women Scholarship Opportunity

From June 7-17, 2020, the Saskatchewan Federation of Labour (SFL) is holding its annual Prairie School for Union Women (PSUW) an empowering, educational school for all women. The school is held at Waskesiu Lake Resort in Prince Albert National Park.

Why do you care?

Because we are offering scholarships for women from the following equality-seeking groups: Indigenous women, women with disabilities, visible minority women, lesbian/bisexual/transgendered women, youth (29 and under). Unemployed women and women in non-unionized jobs can also apply.

The CLC - Prairie Region offers an additional scholarship for a woman to attend the PSUW entitled the *Betty Pickering Memorial Scholarship*. Betty passed away October of 2014 and spent much of her life dedicated to helping others. Betty was a role model for so many utilizing her strengths, determination and generosity to stand for what she so strongly believed in. We are honoured to offer this scholarship in her name.

The PSUW is four days of learning and sharing in a supportive environment. The goals of the school are to develop women's personal and leadership skills, to build solidarity among women workers, and to increase knowledge about the labour movement. You choose one class out of nine to attend.

To qualify you must identify as female and committed to learning in a feminist, anti-racist and inclusive environment. Scholarships include school registration, accommodation and meals.
