- (+) Politely ask your supervisor what work you should prioritize and ask them to provide you with direction
- (+) Take your breaks
- (+) Arrive and leave on time

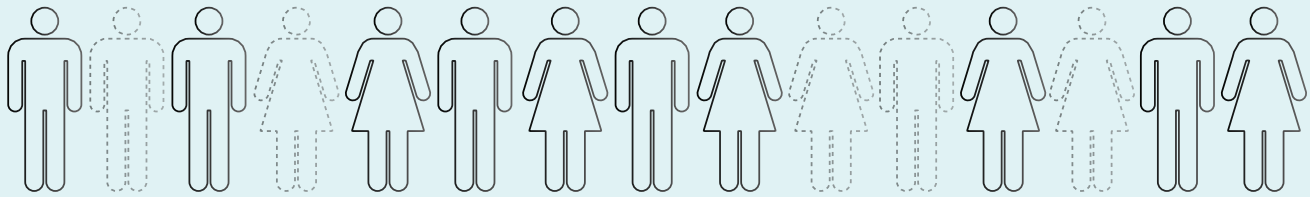
