

Update on increases to Full-Time Equivalents (FTEs)

As we reported in our last bargaining update on March 18th, Canterbury has agreed to offer regular positions with higher FTEs. They have asked all employees to indicate their preferences for scheduling by May 30.

They expect to have a new master rotation ready by the end of June so employees can make their line selections based on seniority. The end result of this process will be that there will be more full-time positions as well as more part-time positions with larger FTEs, instead of relying heavily on pick-up and casual shifts that leave staff without the benefits of a regular position.
