these moves and more information will be provided as it comes available.

It is important to note that all programs impacted by any service relocation/change at Melcor Centre and the train station will be intimately involved in the design and construction of their space.

AHS Capital Management team(s) will be scheduling meetings with department leaders to review specific recommendations. We will then begin rearranging areas to make room for construction and begin design consultations with impacted teams.

We are aware that these changes will affect where patients access care. As we move forward, work through timelines and details, we will ensure the public is aware of any change to access program and service locations.

Below is an idea of the estimated timeline of this initiative.
