Strike Line Dos & Don'ts

The strike line belongs to the Union. Follow these guidelines to maintain a safe and positive strike line.

DO 🗸	DON'T 🖂
Show solidarity with fellow workers.	Don't cross the strike line or go to work unless you are a Designated Essential Services Worker (DESW).
Follow your Strike Captain's directions.	Don't take direction from private security guards or management on the strike line.
Sign in when you arrive at the strike line and sign out before you leave.	Don't assume your Strike Captain will sign in for you. Signing in and out of the strike line is your responsibility.
Always be respectful and peaceful.	Don't disrespect others, including non-union members or the public.
Immediately report safety concerns to your Strike Captain.	Don't ignore safety guidelines or create hazards for others.
Remove yourself from abusive or violent situations and immediately report the incident to your Strike Captain.	Don't threaten or argue with people crossing the line, including scabs. Report any problems to your Strike Captain.
Stay focused on your strike line duties and avoid personal conflicts.	Don't damage property or be violent in any way.
Be prepared; dress for the weather and bring snacks and water.	Don't post photos or make negative comments about your employer on social media.
Keep the line organized and moving to maintain visibility and impact.	Don't speak to the media. Direct media requests to your Strike Captain.
