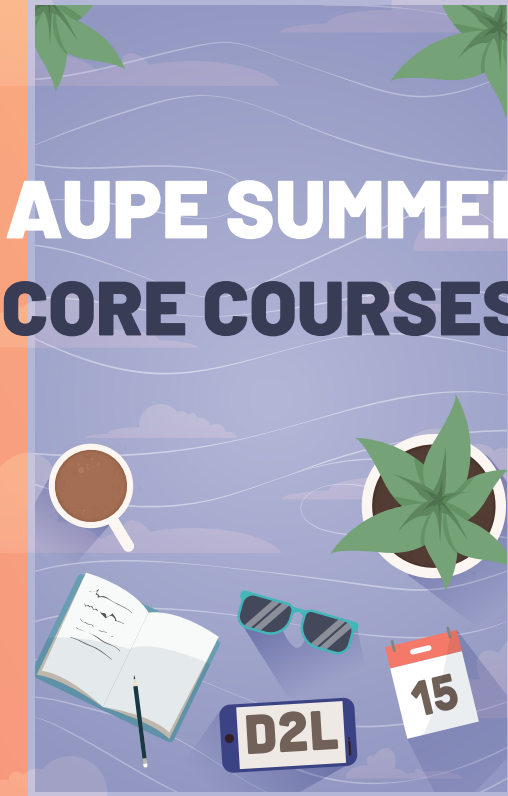

## STRIKE CAPTAIN PREPARDNESS

*In-person (1 day)*

Sometimes strike action must be taken to successfully secure the demands of AUPE members at the bargaining table. Strike Captains are AUPE members who step forward to take on a leadership role in supporting fellow members during strike action. This unique, in-person course is designed to prepare 2025 Strike Captains with all the tools, knowledge, and practice to lead an effective strike line with AUPE support. Additionally, you learn how to assist members with reporting for their picket line duty, receiving their strike pay, their picketing rights and responsibilities, and answers to many of their questions while on the line. Although this course isn't in the current calendar, it will be ordered extensively throughout the upcoming education period.

## BASIC CONFLICT MANAGEMENT
